VIII. TRAINING Joanne Summers

When it came to tearing down, if you blinked, you would have missed the well-oiled process. I am very grateful to Berdell who became my right hand man when it came to working the Open and Utility practice ring. Many thanks to Linda and Debbie for bringing their equipment and to Phyllis for being at training every week through all that heat and humidity. The Club had a very busy summer.

We are now inside till the second week in April.

We will not have class October 5 and 6. Hatboro will have the grounds those two days.

There have been several changes the training schedule. Wednesday will stay the same till October 19. We will have the new schedule up on the Web page. 
SHOW READY CLASS PLUS:
