Dear Allentown Dog Training Club Member,

The club has a demo team which provides demonstrations and information to groups throughout our community. We would like to actively promote the demo team and are seeking to update the team's roster. We encourage anyone interested to review the following statement and to seek board approval for your dog by contacting Joanne Summers at joannetsummers@rcn.com about becoming a team member.

The ADTC demo team is active on an as needed basis. Most demos are for schools, summer playgrounds, scouts, nursing facilities, etc. The team's past appearances include a request to be present at a community day to promote the theme of safety around dogs for children. No dog has too little or too much training. Novice dogs show how to start and advanced dogs show what these skills grow into. It is nice to have a variety of dogs represented. We sometimes have only three dog and handler teams who are able to go, or we may have a dozen. Most importantly, the dog must be able to interact with touchy feely kids and adults and be well mannered around other dogs. You may do what you are comfortable doing or only socialize if that suits you better. A number of years ago after a demo of utility exercises, one of the kids asked if any of the dogs could shake hands. No one could! It is always nice if your dog has a trick – kids are more impressed with them! All dogs must be approved by the board.
